2.1 Module Door Station Appearance

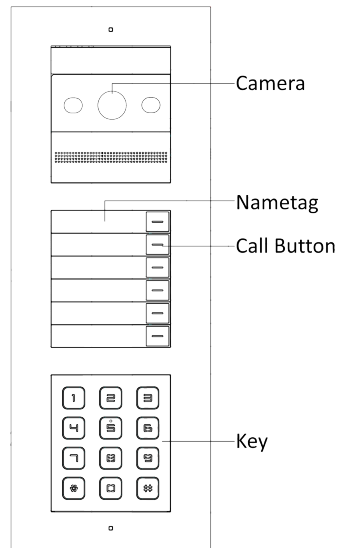


Figure 2-1 Module Door Station Appearance

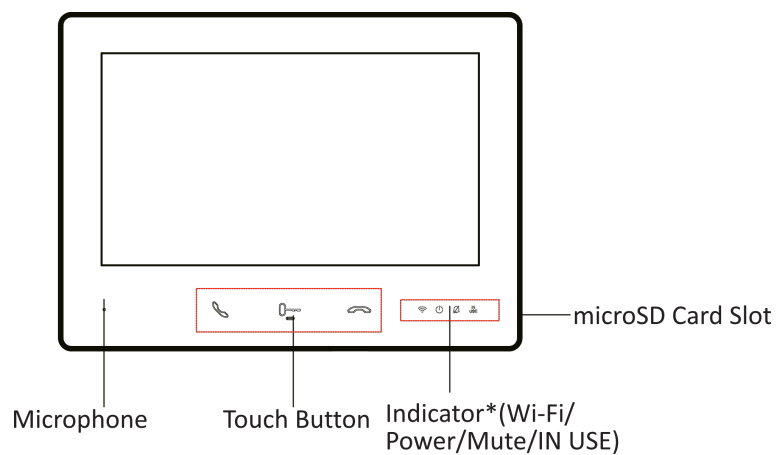


Figure 2-2 Appearance

Chapter 3 Operation on Door Station

3.1 Call Indoor Station from Door Station

After powering on the device, the door station can call indoor station.

Steps

1. The door station call indoor station directly.
2. The indoor station views the live video.

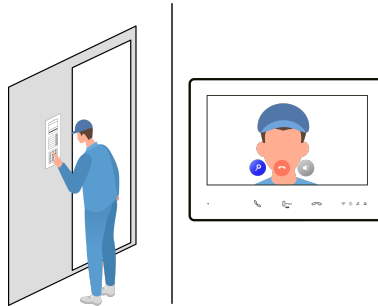


Figure 3-1 Call Indoor Station

3.2 Unlock Door

Unlock Door by Public Password



Note

You should install the keypad module to complete the following operation.

1. Enter **【#】** + Public Password + **【#】** to open the door.

Unlock Door by Card



Note

You should install the card reader module to complete the following operation.

1. Swipe the card on the card induction area to unlock the door.

Chapter 4 Operation on Indoor Station

4.1 Menu

You can mute, unlock, view live videos, and check status on the menu page.

Note

The Live View icon can be disabled.

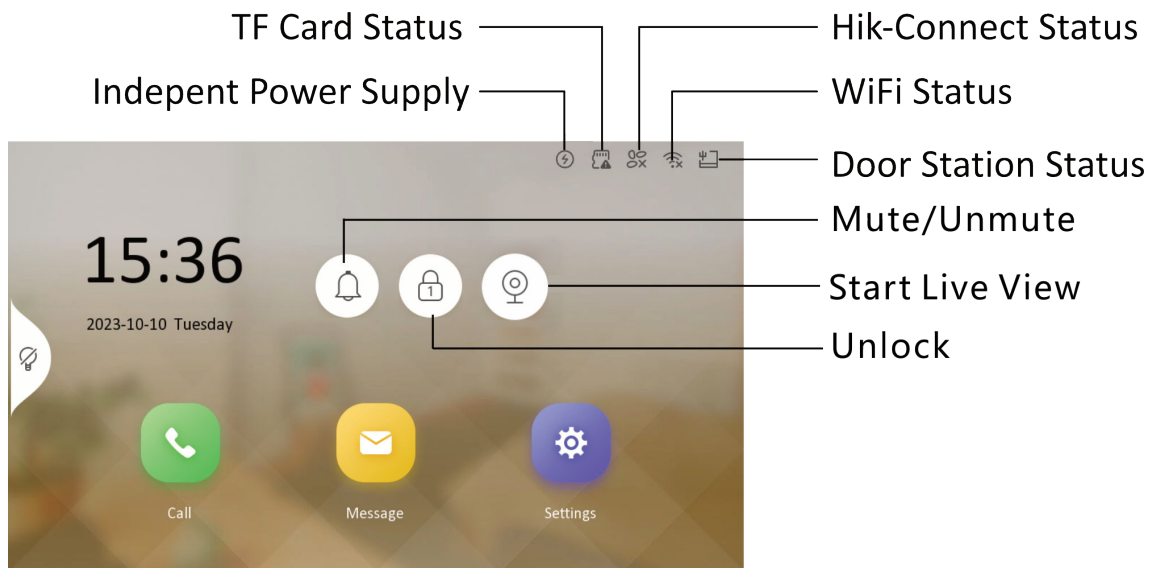


Figure 4-1 View Status



Note

After muting, there will be no ringtone when receiving a call.



Unlock linked device.

By default, you can unlock the main door station.



View live videos of main door station.

4.2 Set Live View

On the live view page, you can view the live video of linked door station, outer door station and sub door station.

Steps

1. Tap **Settings** →  → **Configuration** →  to enter the page of Local Information.

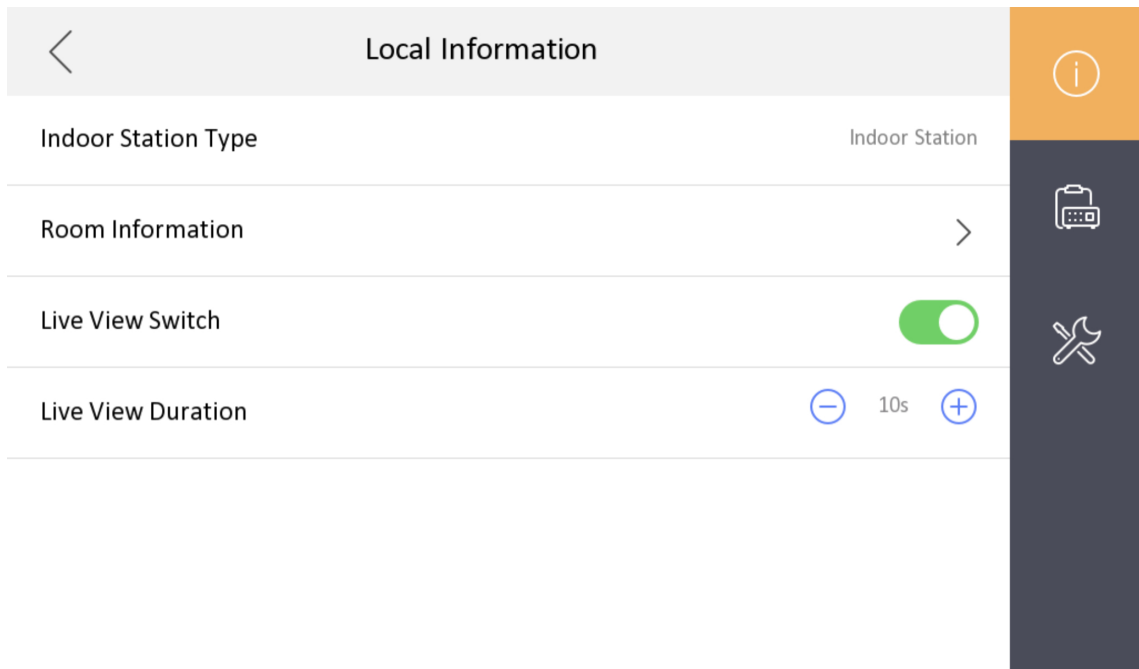


Figure 4-2 Local Information

2. Enable **Live View**.

The live view icon will be shown on the main page.

3. Tap **Live View** on the main page and select a camera to start live view.

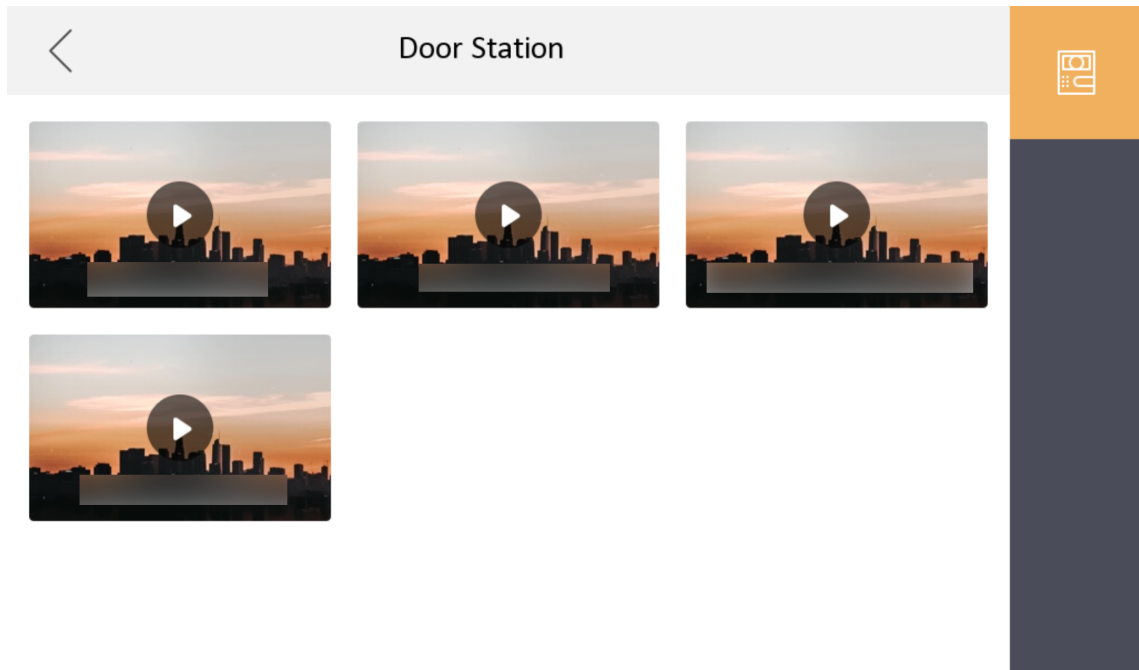


Figure 4-3 Live View

4.3 View Call Logs

Steps

1. Tap **Call** →  to enter the call log page.
2. Tap a piece of call logs in the list to call back.

Note

- The indoor station saves call logs from door stations, outer door stations, and sub door stations.
 - Hold a piece of call logs to open the call logs handling menu. Tap **Delete** to delete the piece of call logs. Tap **Clear** to delete all pieces of call logs.

4.4 View Capture Logs

Steps

1. Tap **Message** → .
2. You can view all capture logs.

4.5 Shortcut Settings

Unlock Keys

Tap **Settings** →  → **Shortcut Settings** to enter the Shortcut Settings page.

Unlock Key

The unlock icon  will be displayed on the main page.

Shortcut Keys

You can set different functions to different shortcut keys.

Tap to enable the shortcut key. Set the function, device and lock for the key.

4.6 Volume Settings

Set the microphone volume, prompt sound volume and call volume.

Steps

1. Tap **Settings** →  → **Volume Settings** to enter the volume settings page.

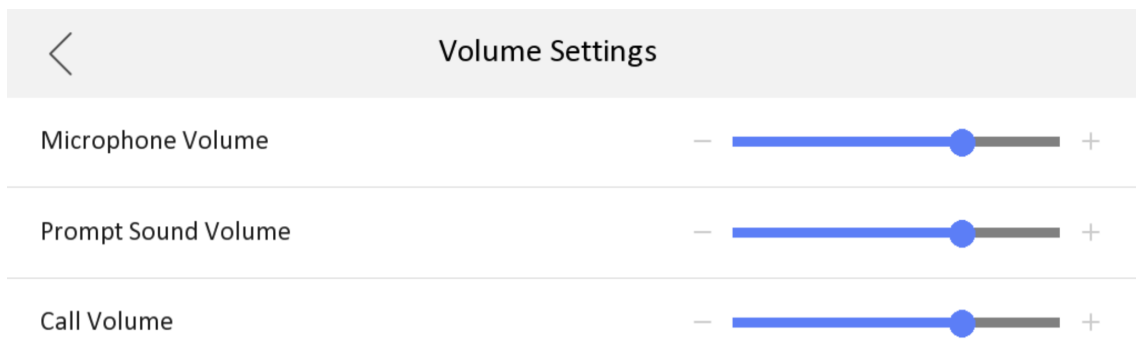


Figure 4-4 Volume Settings Page

4.7 Ringtone Settings

You can set the ringtone on call settings page.

Steps

1. Tap **Settings** →  to enter the call settings page.

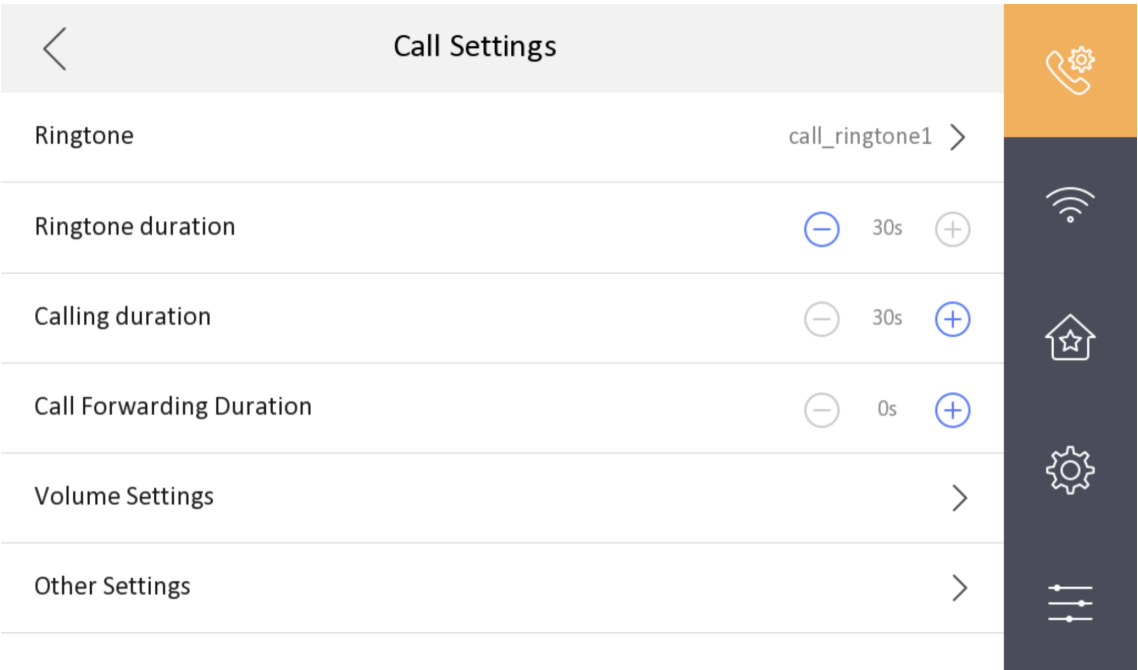


Figure 4-5 Call Settings

4.8 Call Settings

You can set the ring duration, call forwarding time on call settings page.

Steps

- 1. Tap **Settings** →  to enter the call settings page.

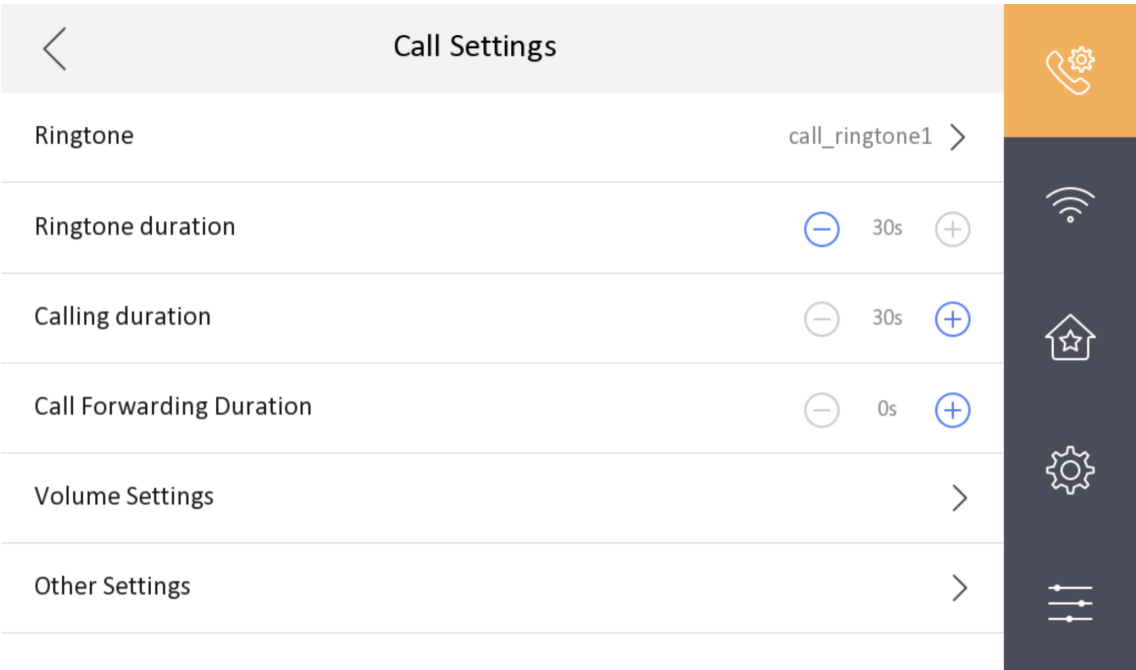


Figure 4-6 Call Settings

4.9 App Settings

The device support adding to **Hik-Connect** and configuration remotely via the client.

4.9.1 Connect to Wi-Fi

After connecting to Wi-Fi, you can view live videos and unlock the door via mobile App. Only some indoor stations support Wi-Fi.

Tap **Settings** → **Wi-Fi Settings** . Enable **Wi-Fi**, and the indoor station can search the Wi-Fi.

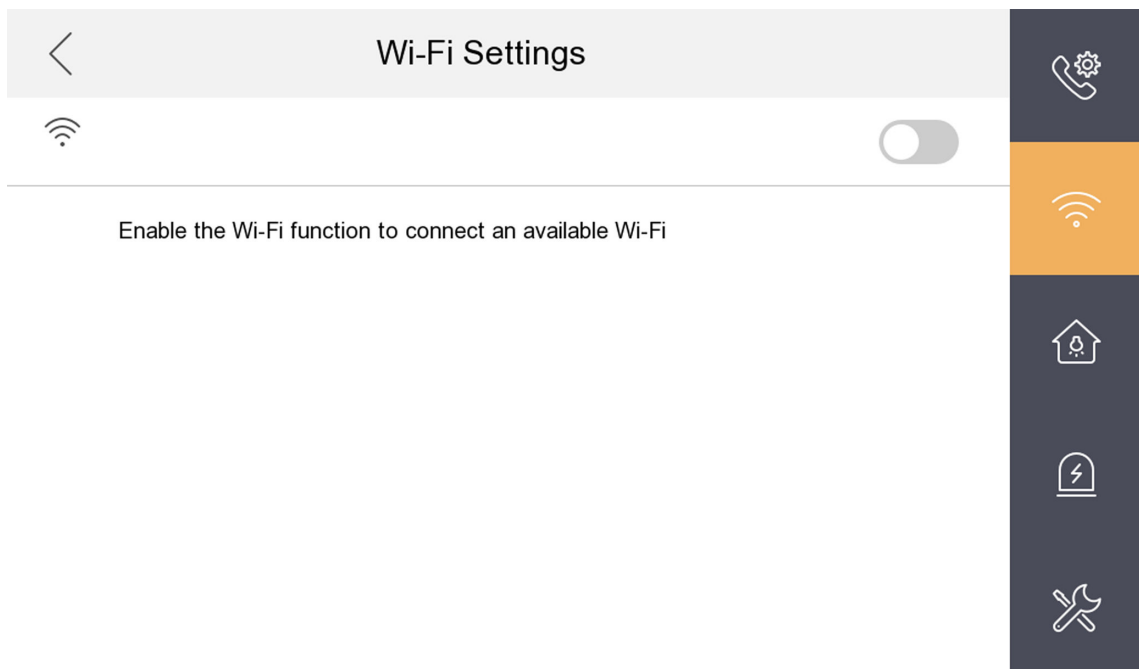


Figure 4-7 Wi-Fi Settings

After connecting to the Wi-Fi, you can operate remotely via the mobile App. The App supports displaying the list of linked door stations. You can unlock the door, receive calls from door stations.

4.9.2 Link to the Mobile Client

Before You Start



Note

The function of the device varies according to different models. Refers to the actual device for detailed information.

Steps

1. Tap **Settings** →  → **Configuration** →  → **Hik-Connect Service Settings** to enter the settings page.
2. Enable **Enable Hik-Connect Service**.

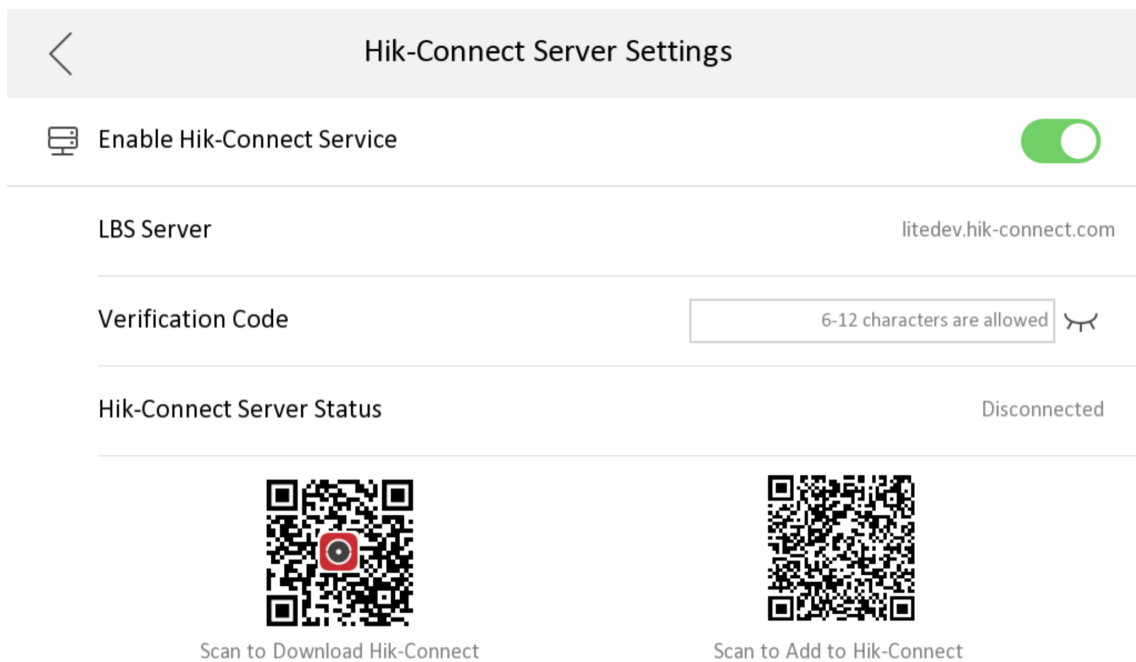


Figure 4-8 Enable Hik-Connect Service

3. Edit **LBS** server and **Verification Code**.

Note

Verification code is used to add the device to mobile client.

4. **Optional:** Scan the QR code on the screen.

Note

- Scan the left QR code on the screen to access Hik-Connect.
- Scan the right QR code on the screen to add the device to the mobile client.

4.9.3 Unlink App Account

Remove the account from the mobile client.

Steps

1. Tap **Settings** →  → **Configuration** .
2. Tap  to enter the system maintenance page.

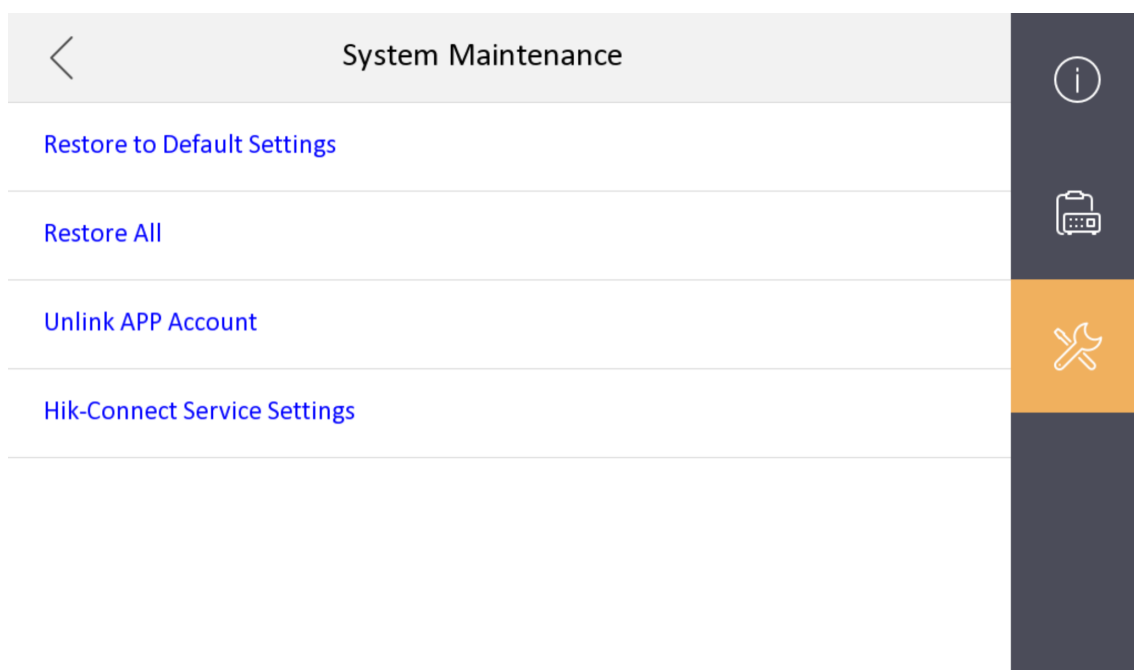


Figure 4-9 System Maintenance

3. Tap **Unlink App Account**, and follow the steps on the page.

4.10 Adjust Brightness

Steps

1. Tap **Settings** →  to enter the General Settings page.

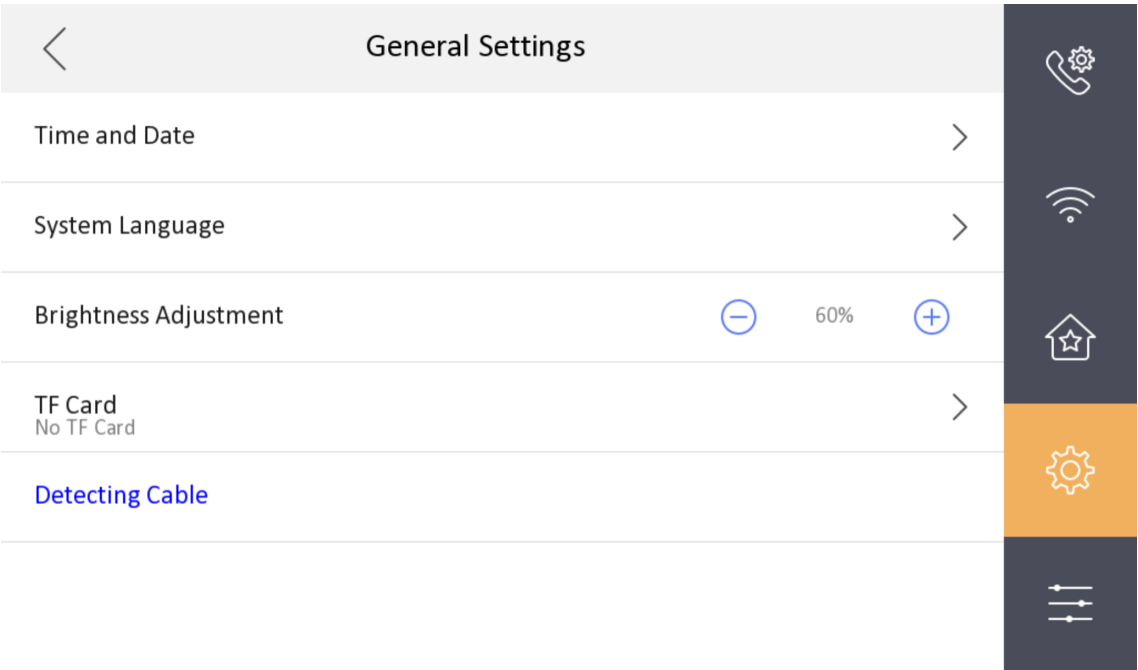


Figure 4-10 General Settings
